

COVID-19 Screening Process and Visitation Guidelines



The safety of our patients, staff and the community remain our priority. We appreciate your cooperation in following our COVID-19 visitation policy outlined below.








Screening Process

You will be asked to provide your name and contact information.

NO VISITING IF:

Temperature will be taken.	Greater than 100 degrees
Have you had close contact with someone with a COVID-19 diagnosis in the last 14 days?	Yes
Have you had a positive COVID-19 diagnosis (last 10-days)?	Yes
Are you experiencing one or more of the following new symptoms: chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, or new loss of taste or smell?	Yes
Are you experiencing two or more of the following new symptoms: muscle or body aches, headache, sore throat, congestion, runny nose?	Yes

Visitor Guidelines

 Designated hours	Visitors <u>must be</u> 18+ years old	 Visitors will be screened upon arrival
One visitor per patient, per day	Visitors restricted to patient room only	No hospital re-entry on the same day
 Hospital will provide visitors with a mask	 Visitors <u>must</u> wear mask at all times	 Visitors <u>must</u> wash hands before entering and exiting room
 Visitors <u>must</u> adhere to 6-foot social distancing	 No eating or drinking permitted in patient room	Visitors <u>NOT PERMITTED</u>: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - COVID-19 diagnosis in the last 10 days - Patients awaiting COVID-19 test results - COVID-19 recovery patients

In some cases, you may be screened by our partner hospital at the point of entry. When you arrive at our facility, we will validate their screen.
